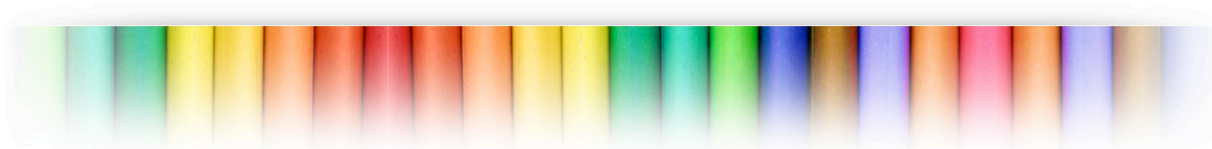

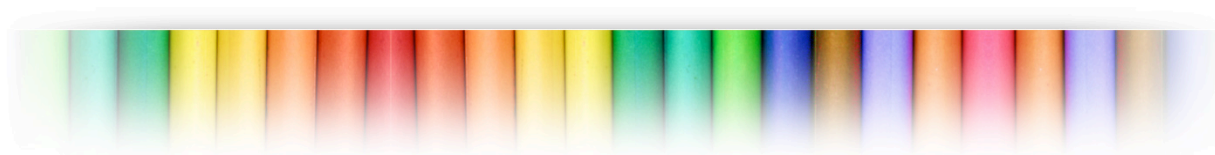

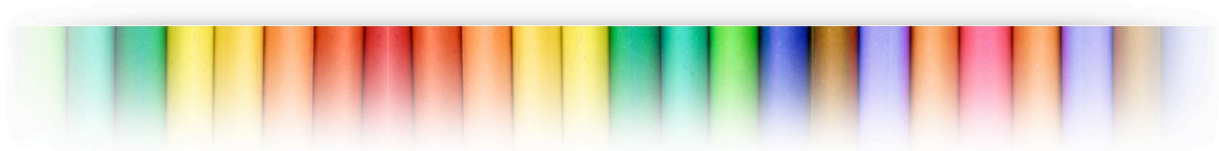
Row Your Boat

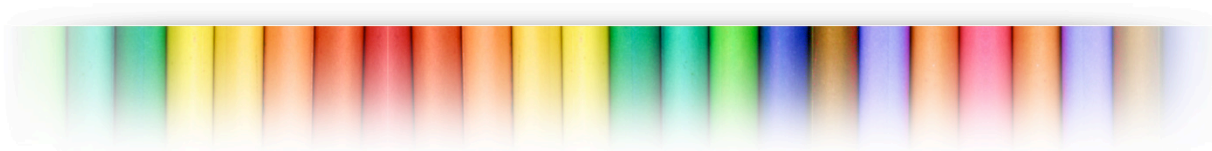

My fair lady.



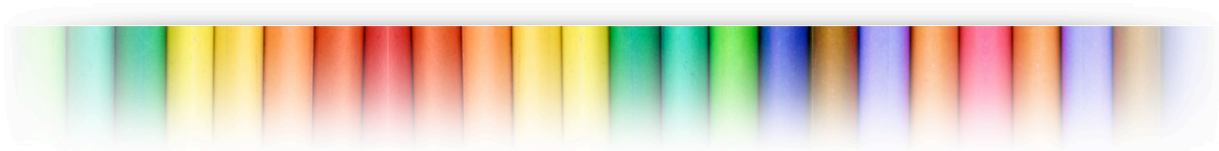

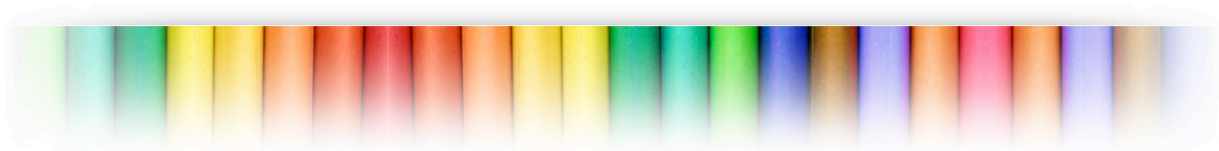
